

# The North West Region Aurifil Award "For Excellence in Embroidery".

Members are invited to submit a piece of modern embroidery, of innovative design, on a subject of personal choice.

There is no size restriction; however thought must be given to the display. There is no guarantee that a large scale work would be displayed to its best advantage.

Embroidery must be the main element in the design which may be worked by hand, machine or combined techniques.

#### Rules

- 1. All members are eligible to enter one piece of work.
- 2. The threads used in the embroidery should include Aurifil threads.
- 3. Only work completed within the last 2 years is eligible to be entered.
- **4.** The work must be entirely the work of the embroiderer, both in design and execution. Copies or adaptations of other artists work are not permissible.

#### **Judging**

Entries will be judged at Regional Day by a representative from Aurifil and the Speaker or Guild Representative.

## Judging criteria

- 1. Creativity of design.
- 2. Skill and quality of workmanship in the execution of the embroidery.
- 3. Suitability of techniques used in the chosen design.
- **4.** Presentation of the work.
