



**The North West Region
Aurifil Award
"For Excellence in Embroidery".**

Members are invited to submit a piece of modern embroidery, of innovative design, on a subject of personal choice.

There is no size restriction; however thought must be given to the display. There is no guarantee that a large scale work would be displayed to its best advantage.

Embroidery must be the main element in the design which may be worked by hand, machine or combined techniques.

Rules

1. All members are eligible to enter one piece of work.
2. The threads used in the embroidery should include Aurifil threads.
3. Only work completed within the last 2 years is eligible to be entered.
4. The work must be entirely the work of the embroiderer, both in design and execution. Copies or adaptations of other artists work are not permissible.

Judging

Entries will be judged at Regional Day by a representative from Aurifil and the Speaker or Guild Representative.

Judging criteria

1. Creativity of design.
2. Skill and quality of workmanship in the execution of the embroidery.
3. Suitability of techniques used in the chosen design.
4. Presentation of the work.
