



**The North West Region
Rose Bowl Competition**

Rules

1. All members are eligible to submit one piece of work for this competition. The theme will have been announced at the Regional Day 2 years previously.
2. Only work completed during the last 2 years may be entered.
3. The work must be entirely the work of the embroiderer.
4. The starting point or source of inspiration may be from a photograph, postcard, magazine picture or advertisement.
5. There is no size restriction on any dimension although there cannot be any guarantee that a large scale work would be displayed to its best advantage.

Judging

Entries will be judged at the Regional Day by members attending.

There will be voting slips and time to vote during the morning of the meeting.

Criteria for Judging

1. Innovation in use of traditional techniques and materials.
2. Interpretation of theme.
3. Presentation of work

Prizes

The 1st prize is a Rose Bowl engraved with winner's name, held for one year, plus a gift token and Certificate.

The entries judged 2nd and 3rd receive gift tokens and certificates.

Presentation

The prizes will be presented by the Speaker, or a Guild Representative.
